## Qualifying Life Events and Your Health Benefits



You have 30 days to make changes to your health benefits when you have a

Qualifying Life Event such as:



- Marital Status (Marriage, Divorce, Death, Legal Separation & Annulment)
- Number of Dependents (Birth, Adoption, Death, Divorce)
- Employee, Spouse or Dependent Employment Status (Gaining or Ceasing eligibility)
- Dependent Child Status (Gaining or Losing eligibility)
- Change in Residence (Moving out of service area which affects eligibility)
- Judgement, Decree or Court Order (Consistent with plan eligibility)
- Medicare & Medicaid (Gaining or Losing eligibility)
- Significant Cost or Coverage Change (Change in Benefit Package Options or Cost)
- Unpaid FMLA
- Gain or Loss of Other Coverage

Requests to change your health benefits, along with supporting documentation (e.g. marriage certificate), are required to be submitted within 30 days of a qualifying life event.
