## Navigation: Main Menu > Schedule > [Select a Schedule]

- 1. On the schedule, open the **Schedule Pattern Editor** for specific employees with the same schedule pattern by doing one of the following.
  - Double-click an employee.
  - Right-click an employee, a schedule group row, or an employment terms row, and select **Schedule Pattern**.
  - Select the check box next to the employee's name to select multiple employees, then right-click any one of them and select **Schedule Pattern**.
  - Use Shift+select or Ctrl+select to select multiple employees, then right-click any one of them and select **Schedule Pattern**.
- 2. Select the tab of the pattern you want to rename.
- 3. On the tab, select the down arrow to open the pattern drop-down list, then select **Rename**.
- 4. At the **Name** field, enter a name.
- 5. Select Apply.
- 6. Select **Save**.
